Concept submissions are due no later than April 1, 2016. Submissions will be reviewed by the Michigan Health Endowment Healthy Ottawa Fund Grant Committee in April of 2016. Organizations whose concepts are considered to have the most potential for advancing the CHIP objectives will be invited to submit a full grant proposal no later than June 17, 2016.
