GHACF Awards Over \$900k for Scholarships



This spring, the GHACF and its affiliates—the Allendale Community Foundation and Coopersville Area Community Foundation—awarded **\$907,749** in scholarships to help graduating students further their education and work toward their goals. Nine Community Partners Awarded Grants

Our most recent round of grants, **totaling \$775,684** have been awarded to nine community partners!

Arbor Circle

• \$4,000 to support the coordination and administration of the 2025 Ottawa County Youth Assessment Survey which provides vital data on youth trends and challenges.

City of Grand Haven

Up to \$15,848 will help the City of Grand Haven purchase <u>ADA</u>
 <u>compliant</u>picnic tables and shade coverings (including at least two that are ADA compliant) for the newly renovated Riverview Deck.

Girl Scouts of Michigan Shore to Shore DreamLab

• \$20,000 to help complete a multi-use programming center designed to

provide a safe, and inclusive space for girls to connect, learn, and grow into confident leaders.

Gracious Grounds' Ability Way

 \$85,000 toward creating a Resident Engagement Department—an affordable housing complex for individuals with intellectual disabilities. The department will provide resources for residents to build meaningful lives and remain successfully housed long-term.

Grand Haven Charter Township

• \$36,766 will aid the modification of Schmidt Heritage Park's JoJo Jogging Trail to keep the area safe and free from parking issues.

Lakeshore Advantage

• \$200,000 over three years to support their economic growth campaign for Northwest Ottawa County.

Mary A. White Early Learning Center

• \$14,250 will support registration cost of a five-day nature-based certification course offered by the Outdoor Discovery Center for Pre-Kindergarten educators in preparation for the center's curriculum.

Read Muskegon

• \$150,000 for the purchase and transformation of a building in Muskegon Heights into a community-centered literacy hub that will serve over 800 individuals annually, including NW Ottawa residents and employees.

The Salvation Army's New Beginnings

• \$250,000 to support emergency housing in Grand Haven, for families of all compositions who are experiencing homelessness.
