Next Round of Grants in the Docket

Our next round of grants will be awarded in December and we can't wait! The GHACF Grants & Program Committee will be distributing funding to several well-deserving local projects and programs – watch for our December newsletter to find out which ones!

In addition, our affiliates in Allendale and Coopersville are getting ready to award multiple grants themselves! Recently, the Allendale Community **Foundation** approved \$9,500.00 in grants to local for-impact partners and \$9,940.73 in Teacher Mini Grants to Allendale Christian School, Allendale Public Schools, and Borculo Christian School. The Coopersville Area **Community Foundation** approved \$17,562 in grants to local for-impact partners.
