Have You Ever Considered Donating Your RMDs?

Required minimal distributions (RMDs) are mandatory withdrawals from tax-deferred retirement accounts, such as traditional IRAs, that individuals must begin taking at age 73. However, if you directly transfer your RMDs to a charity, you can deduct them on your tax return and effectively reduce your income taxes by lowering your adjusted gross income.*

The GHACF—and its affiliates—accept RMDs. However, **RMDs may not go to donor advised funds (DAFs)**.

Our 2026 scholarship applications are now open! Scholarships are based on a range of criteria—from financial need to field-of-study to academic achievements, or perhaps whether a student is a first-generation college student.
